

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: 2 CRITICAL MICROSOFT LIMITATIONS

There are 3 .wmv (windows media video) files “embedded” into the sermon PowerPoint presentation. There are various well-known, yet unsolved issues with playback of .wmv files from within Microsoft PowerPoint. They should be individually inserted and tested on the system they are to be run from. If testing shows playback doesn’t work well, simply delete the slide with the video. You may always play the individual video clips from a normal player outside of PowerPoint, and your results should be better. BE SURE TO TEST ON THE SYSTEM YOU WILL USE FOR YOUR PRESENTATION. Results may vary!!!

1. ALL 3 VIDEO FILES MUST BE KEPT IN THE SAME FOLDER AS THE POWERPOINT_SERMON file when the file is being used, or the PowerPoint Sermon WILL NOT PLAY THE VIDEO. This is a Microsoft Windows/PowerPoint limitation.

2. The pathname to the video files may not exceed 128 characters. This includes your hard drive name, all folders, and the video file name itself. Video will appear to freeze if the path is too long. This is a Microsoft Windows/PowerPoint limitation - [Microsoft Explanation](#):
